You have already done research on this topic. See your BOOK SOURCES "quiz."


Prompt

DETAILED INSTRUCTIONS

INTRODUCTORY PARAGRAPH

In your INTRODUCTION, do three things, in this order:

- 1. First, provide a contemporary **example** of our fascination with celebrity as a HOOK.
 - If you believe our fascination is mostly positive, choose a positive example.
 - If you believe our fascination is mostly negative, choose a negative example.
 - If you believe our fascination is NEUTRAL, choose a neutral example.

- 2. COPY the following statement of **purpose**: "The purpose of this essay is to *evaluate* our fascination with celebrities. Is this obsession of ours good for society?"
- 3. State your **thesis**. Choose one of three positions: This fascination of ours is (a) mostly *positive*, (b) mostly *negative*, or *(c) neutral*.

BODY PARAGRAPH #1

CONCLUDING PARAGRAPH

Now it is time to argue persuasively for your position. Is this fascination of ours mostly good or mostly bad? Summarize your most convincing reasons, but don't just repeat word-forword what you've already said. Should anything be done to change what is happening in our culture? Why or why not?
