This is a ***hanging indent***

Instructions for creating a hanging indent:

Google Docs

With your cursor, select the line(s) that need to be indented.

Then go to **Format > Align & Indent > Indentation options**.

- Under "Special," select "Hanging."
- Press the **Apply** button to save your changes.

Microsoft Word

1. Place your cursor at the beginning of your citation and highlight it.
2. Right click your mouse.
3. Select PARAGRAPH from the pop-up menu.
4. Under **Indentation**, use the Special pull-down menu to select **hanging**.
5. Use the “By” menu to select 0.5”
