

## ANSWERS--Subject-Verb Agreement

English—WALL

Subjects and verbs must AGREE.

- If the subject is SINGULAR, the verb will be SINGULAR.

Example: That girl runs fast.

- If the subject is PLURAL, the verb will be PLURAL.

Example: Those girls run fast.
